History of January 16

- ◆ 1761: The British removed the authority of the French from Pondicherry.
- ◆ 1769: Suniyajit horse racing was organized for the first time in Calcutta.
- ♦ 1989: The Soviet Union announced its plans for a two-year manned mission to Mars.
- ♦ 1992: An extradition treaty was signed between Britain and India.
- ◆ 1556: Philip II became the Emperor of Spain.

Current Affairs Related to 16 January

- Taking air defense cooperation forward, a joint air exercise between India and Japan is starting. The name of this bilateral exercise is Veer Guardian. This is the first edition of this aerial exercise between India and Japan. Its objective is to enhance defense cooperation between the two countries. It will be organized from 12 to 26 January 2023 at Hyakura Air Base in Japan. This will be the first time that a woman fighter pilot of the Indian Air Force will be part of an Indian contingent for an aerial combat in a foreign land.
- The Board of Control for Cricket in India has found a replacement for one of the two jersey sponsors of Team India. The cricket body has signed only Kiran Clothing, makers of Killer Jeans, as the official partner of the Indian cricket team for five months (till 31 May 2023). Keval Kiran Clothing, which also owns brands like Lawman and Integrity, has replaced gaming firm MPL. Under this deal, the flagship brand will be displayed on the right upper chest of Team India's jersey.
- Anurag Kumar was appointed as the Chairman and Managing Director of Electronics Corporation of India Limited. The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the appointment of Kumar to the post till January 31, 2026, the date of his superannuation.
- The World Bank released the Global Economic Prospects Report 2023. In the report, the World Bank has once again reaffirmed its faith in the Indian economy. According to the World Bank, India is expected to be the fastest growing economy among the seven largest emerging markets and developing economies.
- India's fastest payment app RuPay launched in India. RuPay is built with the best of Web 3.0 technology. RuPay provides an enhanced digital payment experience with an excellent user experience.
- Aparna Sen was awarded the Lifetime Achievement Award at the Jaipur Film Festival.

- The Khelo India Senior Women's National Kho Kho League has been held at Chandigarh University Punjab from 10 to 13 January. The league, to be organized in three phases, is being organized by the Kho Kho Federation of India with full financial support from the Union Sports Ministry. A total of 12 teams will participate in the tournament and around 200 players will participate. Apart from this, Kho Kho Women's League for Junior and Sub-Junior age group has been scheduled from January 16 to 19 at Alberta Ekka Kho Kho Stadium, Hotwar, Ranchi.
- ♦ Neeru Yadav aka Hockey Sarpanch has started a new initiative to support the farmers of Lambi Ahir village. Yadav and NABARD have signed an agreement to start Farmer Producer Organization with the help of Society of Indian Institute of Rural Development. Farmer Producer Organization is a company that was formally established by farmers.
 - India's High Commissioner to the UK Vikram K Doraiswamy and Matthew Rycraft signed and exchanged letters to formalize the plan. PM Modi and UK PM Rishi Sunak announced the launch of the Young Professional Scheme at the G20 Summit in Bali, Indonesia. The Young Professional Scheme will enable graduates aged 18.30 years to obtain a 2-year visa to study in each other's countries and help youth understand each other's culture.
- ♦ The Center has adopted new standards for making digital TVs, security systems and chargers. BIS, under the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, has issued new country specific standards for manufacturing Digital TV receivers, USB Type C receptacles, plugs and cables, and video surveillance systems.
- The 7th edition of the Global Investors Summit was inaugurated by PM Modi in Indore. The inaugural session was also attended by Chandrika Prasad Santokhi, President of Suriname and Dr. Mohamed Irfan Ali, President of Guyana.
